


# Burden of breast cancer by numbers


Breast cancer is by far the most common cancer among women



>1.67 million women worldwide are diagnosed each year

Breast cancer represents 25% of all cancers



Every 20 seconds a woman is diagnosed with breast cancer

From 2008-2012 there was a 22% increase in the incidence of breast cancer

1 in 5 breast cancer cases are in women under the age of 50

<1% of all male cancer cases are breast cancer

A woman dies of breast cancer every minute worldwide


>15 million years of healthy life is lost to breast cancer worldwide each year

Every hour, 8 women are diagnosed with advanced breast cancer in Europe


~1/3 of patients first diagnosed with early breast cancer will go on to develop advanced disease

Only 1 in 4 women with advanced breast cancer are alive 5 years after diagnosis

Around 1 in 5 women with breast cancer worldwide have an aggressive type called HER2-positive, meaning there is overexpression of the HER2 protein

50% of people with HER2-positive advanced breast cancer who are treated with the current standard of care progress within 18 months



Every 2 minutes a woman in Europe is diagnosed with HER2-positive breast cancer


Every 5 minutes a woman in Europe dies of HER2-positive breast cancer

~15% of breast cancers are triple negative (TNBC), meaning that the cancer cells have limited expression of oestrogen, progesterone and HER2

16



~75% of breast cancers are hormone receptor-positive, meaning there is overexpression of oestrogen and progesterone on the surface of cancer cells
